Special Notes for Math Students:

- If you are challenging a placement earned by your US high school transcript, you may be able to re-assess with the Assessment Center. We will need to check your transcript to make sure you haven't earned a non-passing grade in a math course before you are allowed to take the Math Guided Self-Placement.
- If you are challenging a placement earned by your Math Guided Self-Placement Session, you may be able to retake the Guided Self-Placement one time within six months of your first session assuming you haven't earned a non-passing grade in a math course.
- Those students who previously took the Math test and were eligible for a retest may be eligible for a Math placement earned by US high school transcript or Math Guided Self-Placement Session assuming you haven't earned any non-passing grades in a math course.
