A.A. Degree - Intercultural Studies

Major Requirements

Complete all requirements for the Certificate of Proficiency - Intercultural Studies as listed above, except where 16 units are required in Options 1, 2 & 3 above, select 20 units. Also, complete all additional A.A. Degree General Education Requirements.
