California State University General Education - Breadth (CSUGE)

All students must meet general education (GE) requirements to receive a bachelor's degree from the California State University (CSU). A minimum of 72 quarter units is required for GE which includes a minimum of 12 quarter units of upper-division courses. Students may complete all of the lower-division GE requirements at a California Community College (CCC) before transfer to the CSU.

CSUGE Breadth is a lower-division, 58 quarter unit pattern. Up to 58 of the 72 general education units required can be certified by a CCC. Students who complete all areas of CSUGE Breadth with 58 quarter units may be certified and will not be required to complete any additional lowerdivision GE course work after transfer. Full certification does not exempt students from any unmet lower division graduation requirements for the campus awarding the B.A./B.S. degree. A CCC can certify each Subject Area (Area A, B, C, D, E) or the whole pattern. CSU provides CCC transfer students with two system-wide options for fulfilling CSU lower-division GE requirements: CSUGE Breadth and the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) for CSU. Students should meet with a counselor or adviser to determine which pattern is appropriate.

Though completion of CSUGE (or IGETC) is not a transfer admission requirement, most students should make completion of all or most of CSUGE (or IGETC) a priority along with completion of lower-division major coursework. Students in high-unit majors such as engineering, some math-based fields, sciences and technical majors are generally advised to focus on fulfilling lower-division major course requirements over GE requirements. These students should work closely with a counselor or academic advisor.

The De Anza College CSUGE pattern requires completion of one ICS course in Area C or D. As a result of this CSUGE pattern specific to De Anza, students must be careful when utilizing CSU transfer tools or referencing the CSUGE information for De Anza at www.ASSIST.org. Please see a counselor or academic advisor if you have any questions.

To be eligible for upper-division transfer, students must successfully complete 90 CSU-transferable quarter units with a grade point average of 2.0 or better (2.4 for California nonresidents)* in all transferable college units attempted. At least 45 of those units must be courses applicable towards CSUGE Breadth (see below), and must include Areas A1, A2, A3, and B4. CSU campuses may limit the required 45-units to CSUGE Breadth Area- unit requirements so those campuses would, for example, only apply 12-15 units from Area B towards the 45 required units. For admission purposes, the 45-units of CSUGE Breadth courses must be completed with a grade of C- or better in each course. However, with the exception of Areas A1, A2, A3, and B4, CSU campuses may have different grading policies. Students are advised to check with the campus they are interested in for details.

Note: For certification purposes, CSUGE Breadth Areas A1, A2, A3 and B4 must be completed with a C grade or better (see below).

Note: Some CSU campuses do not allow courses in Areas A1, A2, A3 and B4 to be completed during the last term prior to transfer.

* These are minimum requirements to be considered for admission. In the case of high-demand and impacted majors/campuses or when enrollment restrictions are enforced, a 2.0 GPA may not be competitive and the level of transfer preparedness may also be considered.

COURSES ON CSUGE - BREADTH

- A course <u>must</u> be on CSUGE Breadth (in the specified Area) the term it is completed in order to apply. Courses may be added to CSUGE Breadth mid-academic year, so students should always refer to the most up-to-date CSUGE Breadth pattern when selecting courses each term. Check <u>www.ASSIST.org</u> and <u>www.deanza.edu/articulation/ge-requirements.html</u> on a regular basis.
- Areas A1, A2, A3 and B4 must be completed with a C or better for certification. Though not recommended, a grade of "Credit" or "Pass" may be used if the college's policy states that it is equivalent to a grade of C or better. A "Pass" at De Anza is achieved with a grade of C or better. Students are advised to consult with a counselor or adviser before selecting this grading option.
- Though a course may be listed in more than one Area, it can only be counted in one Area for certification.

A few things to consider: Some CSU campuses set limits on the number of units that may be taken for Credit/Pass. Courses used towards a major should be taken for a letter grade, unless otherwise specified. CSU has campus-specific policies which may not allow courses to be double-counted for major and GE. Check CSU college catalogs and websites for campus-specific policies.

COURSEWORK FROM OTHER COLLEGES

- Courses taken at another CCC will be applied in the approved Areas designated by that college when the courses were completed. Visit www.ASSIST.org for more information.
- Courses from regionally accredited institutions could apply towards CSUGE provided they meet CSUGE criteria and standards.
- Only foreign coursework from U.S. regionally accredited institutions may be applied towards CSUGE. Although De Anza College will not certify other foreign coursework, a CSU campus may elect to apply them towards GE after a student has transferred.

Students must arrange to have official transcripts sent to the De Anza Admissions and Records Office (A&R). Evaluation time varies so this process should be initiated by the student as soon as possible. If De Anza College is unable to determine the applicability of a non-CCC course towards CSUGE, it is the student's responsibility to provide additional information about the course. Writing samples may be needed for courses reviewed for Areas A2 and A3 and, if applicable, for Area C, if a second writing course was completed.

CSUGE CERTIFICATION

The CSUGE certification is an official document sent directly from De Anza to another institution verifying the courses/exams applied towards CSUGE. This is not an automatic process. Upon enrolling in final required courses and receiving conditional admission to the university, students must submit a request for certification to De Anza's Admissions & Records (A&R) Office. All necessary documentation (transcripts, exams) must be received and evaluated by De Anza prior to this request. NOTE: The certification process may be delayed if transcripts/exams have not been previously evaluated. (See section on *Coursework from Other Colleges* above.)

- Advanced Placement (AP) official reports must be sent to A&R directly from the College Board in order to apply.
- College Level Examination Program (CLEP) official reports must be sent to De Anza's A&R Office directly from College Board in order to apply.
