Reflective Writing Assignment

For the final writing assignment, you must write 3 paragraphs. The question you must answer is: **Why should I move onto ESL 273?**

To answer this question, you will write 3 paragraphs. Each paragraph will have a specific controlling idea.

Paragraph 1: One Strength Paragraph 2: One Weakness

Paragraph 3: One thing I have learned in ESL 263

Remember, you must connect your strength, weakness and thing learned to why it prepares you for ESL 273.

Additionally, you must choose two pieces of your writing to include in your portfolio. You must pick:

One In-class Writing Assignment (hand-written copy)
One Out-of-class Writing Assignment (typed final version)

When you are thinking about your strength, your weakness and the thing you have learned, think about the writing examples that you are including. Just as you have used readings in your writing in this class, you should use your other writing assignments as examples in this reflective writing assignment.

What we're looking for in the reflective writing assignment:

- Analysis of your own writing process and evaluation of your strengths and weaknesses as a writer
- Clear organization
- Well-developed, focused paragraphs
- Specific examples, details
- Wide variety of well-constructed sentences
- Correct grammar, spelling and punctuation
