Here are some off campus activities that you may choose to write about worth up to 5 points each. Choose from **up to two** of the following options:

1. Visit the **Native American Art galleries (Arts of the Americas)** on the 2nd floor, at the **Cantor Center**, Stanford University (for directions and information see link <https://museum.stanford.edu/>) - Write about your experience in the galleries.
2. Visit the **De Young Museum** in Golden Gate Park, San Francisco, and explore the Native American arts gallery OR see the current exhibit (OPEN ONLY UNTIL FEB 11th), *Teotihuacan: City of Water, City of Fire*. THIS EXHIBIT REQUIRES a ticket for entry and is quite expensive. (For directions and information see link <https://deyoung.famsf.org/>) - Write about the gallery or exhibition.
3. Visit the San Francisco **Women's Building mural** by Maestrapeace at 18th and Lapidge in the Mission District. Take a **photo of yourself** with the mural to document your visit and write about the mural.
4. Visit the **Japanese American Museum** in San Jose (for directions and information see link <http://www.jamsj.org/>). Write about Japantown and the museum visit.

Write a 600-word document of your impressions and analysis of the exhibition or mural FOR EACH OPTION chosen. **Include a photo of yourself at the site in your paper as proof of your visit.**

***In addition to the above, Instructor MAY announce select **ON-CAMPUS events** as extra credit options WORTH 3 points each. **Write a 600-page reaction paper to the event and include proof of your attendance (photo of you or handouts)**
