Extra Credit Assignments – 5 points possible for one submission, up to 8 points for two.

Here are some off campus activities that you may choose to write about worth up to 5 points each. Choose from **up to two** of the following options:

1. Visit the **Native American Art galleries (Arts of the Americas)** on the 2nd floor, at the **Cantor Center**, Stanford University (for directions and information see link on my webpage under **Museum Links - Local**) - Also visit **at least one** of the **Special Exhibitions on Ledger art**, Red Horse: Drawings of the Battle of the Little Bighorn (closes May 9), Contemporary Perspectives on the Battle of Little Big Horn (closes June 13) **OR the exhibit Who We Be**, on visual art, race, and diversity. Write about this exhibition as well as the permanent Native American galleries.
2. Visit the **Oakland Museum of California** and visit both floors of the museum (for directions and information see link on my webpage under **Museum Links - Local**). Find an example of an artwork by at least ONE artist we studied in class this quarter and write about the piece in your paper.
3. Visit the San Francisco **Women's Building mural** by Maestrapeace at 18th and Lapidge in the Mission District. Take a **photo of yourself** with the mural to document your visit and write about the mural.
4. Visit the **Japanese American Museum** in San Jose (for directions and information see link on my webpage under **Museum Links - Local**). Write about Japantown and the museum visit.
5. Visit the **Museum of Art and History in Santa Cruz** (for directions and information see link on my webpage under Museum Links - Local). See the current exhibition, **The Kinsey African American Art and History Collection** (closes May 22). Write about the exhibit.

Write a 600-word document of your impressions and analysis of the exhibition, event or mural FOR EACH OPTION chosen. **Include a photo of yourself at the site in your paper as proof of your visit.**

***In addition to the above, Instructor MAY announce select **ON-CAMPUS events** as extra credit options WORTH 3 points each. **Write a 600-page reaction paper to the event and include proof of your attendance (photo of you or handouts)**
