The purpose and objective of this activity is to increase your awareness of different settings and roles of the nurse, and to increase your understanding of how various members of the health care team interact in the provision of quality, interdisciplinary care. Additionally, you are to discover any differences and similarities in the provision of this care to the geriatric patient, as compared to a younger adult patient. Note: some sites (marked with \*) often overlap from later morning into late afternoon shifts (possibly no postconference that day, depending on the flow of the work).
