

## **Observation Day at ECH Instructions:**

*Please remember to plan for adequate time in the morning commute and parking if you have a later start time!*

**(650) 940 – 7000; ask for appropriate dept.**

**DRESS IN FULL UNIFORM FOR ALL OBSERVATIONS!** Bring minimal belongings as there is usually no place to store them.

Operating Room: arrive at 6:45am. Report to the desk just inside the OR on 2B. Use code “VIS” in pyxis to obtain scrubs. Please also check the scrubs back in (“return” in pyxis) at end of day.

Admission unit: begin at 7:00am. Report to Pre-Op/Short Stay unit on 2B. IF they want you in scrubs, use code “VIS” in pyxis to obtain scrubs. Please also check the scrubs back in (“return” in pyxis) at end of day. Be aware that traffic and parking will be difficult at this start time, so plan for extra time.

Endoscopy: begin at 7:00am. OLD HOSPITAL. Report to Endoscopy unit on 1st floor (lobby level, toward the back). IF they want you in scrubs, use code “VIS” in pyxis to obtain scrubs. Please also check the scrubs back in (“return” in pyxis) at end of day. Be aware that traffic and parking will be difficult at this start time, so plan for extra time.

Diabetic Educ: Start time varies but day is usually is late morning to early evening (you will be advised). Report to Beya Sioson’s office (Diab. Education) in the OLD hospital, first floor, behind the old pt registration area. You can call her on Vocera as needed.

Care Coordinator: begin at 7:30am. Instructor will give further instructions as to where to meet the Care Coordinator. Be aware that traffic and parking will be difficult at this start time, so plan for extra time.

Cardiac Cath Lab: arrive at 7:00am. You must call the business day before to make sure they have cases. (650) 988- 7555. Let instructor know immediately if there are no cases scheduled! The CCL is on 2A, near the OR. IF they want you in scrubs, use code "VIS" in pyxis to obtain scrubs. Please also check the scrubs back in ("return" in pyxis) at end of day. Be aware that traffic and parking will be difficult at this start time, so plan for extra time.

Cardiac Rehab: begin at 9:30am. There is ~20 min. pre-work required for this site, obtain materials from instructor and check website for prep instructions. Report to the Cardio/Pulmonary Rehab Dept., which is in the OLD HOSPITAL on the ground floor (basement). Bring your stethoscope to help take BP's. Be aware that traffic and parking will be difficult at this start time, so plan for extra time.

Resp. Therapy: arrive at 6:55am. Report to the Respiratory Medicine Dept., which is on the ground floor, in the "A" tower elevator alcove (next to elevators). Bring your stethoscope.

PT/OT: begins at 8:00am. Report to the PT office on 4A. Be aware that traffic and parking will be difficult at this start time, so plan for extra time.

Outpatient Dialysis: begins at 7:00. Report to the nurses station. Outpatient Dialysis is in the building behind the OLD HOSPITAL, corner of South and Hospital Drives.

Flex Nurse: arrive at 6:55am. Report to the Staffing Office on 1C, in the hallway behind the public elevators. You can call her on Vocera as needed (say "Flex Nurse"). Bring your stethoscope.

Critical Care Unit: arrive at 6:55am. Report to Critical Care Unit on 3A. Bring your stethoscope.

Radiation Oncology: arrive at 8:30am. Report to the Radiation Oncology Building on South Drive across the street from the OLD Hospital. Be aware that traffic and parking will be difficult at this start time, so plan for extra time.

Wound Care: arrive at 8:00am. Meet the Wound Care Nurse in her office on 2C, across from main nurses station. You can call her on Vocera as needed (page "wound care nurse"). Be aware that traffic and parking will be difficult at this start time, so plan for extra time.

Palliative Care: arrive at 8:00am. Meet Kathleen Fahey in her office on 3A, room 3A326 (near the Critical Care Unit). You can call her on Vocera as needed. Be aware that traffic and parking will be difficult at this start time, so plan for extra time.

Pathways: the Pathways nurse will call you and arrange a meeting time and place.
