Zombies

Philosophical Zombies play an important role in the philosophy of mind, believe it or not. You have one more 10 point group project to complete this quarter, and here it is:

In your groups you will create a comic strip on a piece of construction paper of at least 3' x3' in dimensions. Your strip should have 6 panels at the minimum, and no more than 10. Your comic strip should address in some way the following questions:

- 1) Philosophical zombies have been used by some philosophers, like David Chalmers, to help think about issues in the philosophy of mind. What point or argument is being made by the example of zombies?
- 2) What view does the zombie argument try to refute or criticize? How does it do this?
- 3) Do you think the zombie argument is a good one, why or why not?

You will be graded on how well your strip addresses these points, but feel free to have fun with the project too. The key to a good comic strip is making your points very concise without wasting words, and using the drawings to communicate your point as much as possible.

This project is due Next Tuesday in class. All individuals must participate and will be given an opportunity to evaluate the contribution of each member in the group
