- 1. Approval of Agenda:** approved with amendments.

- 3a. Committee Member Approval:** Randy Claros from Financial Aid was approved to serve on the Diversity Advisory Committee as the Classified representative.
- 3b. Committee Member Approval:** Pat Cornely from the Kirsch Center was approved as the Classified representative on the hiring committee for the ESA Technician position.
- 4. Sustainability Management Plan:** The plan was approved.
- 5. Heart Walk Report:** Melodie distributed copies of a report that she and CJ had put together on the American Heart Association walk that was held on September 16. Senators discussed this year's walk and how to improve it next year.
- 6a. Budget:** Mi announced that Classified Senate will be receiving a one-time B budget augmentation of \$5,250. Olivia suggested that Christina Espinosa-Pieb be invited to the next meeting to discuss which groups currently have no budget at all so Classified Senate can decide whether it would be appropriate to share some of the augmentation money with them. The Senate approved the suggestion.
- 7. CS Activities for 07-08:** From a list of proposed activities that was drawn up at the Leadership Retreat, Senate discussed each and approved the list, with an event date assigned to each. Two additional activities were added: the AHA walk in September 08 and the ACS Relay for Life in July 08 and these were also approved.

Those who choose to do so will attend the inaugural; the rest of the senators will walk their section to meet the employees they represent and give them a CS business card and a small gift.
- 9. Announcements:** Olivia distributed an information sheet about the Jean Elwell Faculty-Staff Memorial Scholarship and it was noted that the scholarship is also in the name of Kathleen Burson.
