3. Computer Technology Task Force Committee: Lyndell reported that the survey to locate those employees not having easy computer access has been translated into 5 languages, and it should go out in about two weeks. Those interested in helping with the implementation can let Lyndell or a senate representative know. President Murphy has promised financial help with the implementation. Lyndell said training may begin later this summer.
