Approval of Agenda

The agenda item #3 was moved to item #2. It was moved by M. Cheney and seconded by T. Ehle approve the amended agenda.

Introductions

Everyone introduced themselves.

President B. Murphy gave a 2009-2010 budget and passed out a handout. He shared information about the current De Anza budget with amount of funds given by the state. De Anza reduced 66 class sections, eliminated the Job Corp program for winter quarter 2009. We grew our enrollment even without Job Corp. There were 60 part-time faculty who didn't get to teach so there were job losses. There will be no Job Corp program in spring 2009 or in the future. There will be a special state election in May 2009 and there could be a budget adjustment in June.

The July1, 2009 – June 30, 2010 budget is being projected at \$11 million with salaries & benefits for the Foothill De Anza District. There is an anticipated no growth funding. We need to grow 7% enrollment. De Anza College needs to suspend not eliminate 10 faculty, 2 administrative and 14 classified professional positions by not filling them. On page 6 there is a bottom line of 5. \$1 million that needs to be reduced. De Anza's share would be 2.5 million

M. Cheney moved and seconded by T. Ehle to adjourn the meeting.
A. Guevara adjourned the meeting at 4 p.m.
