- No degree audit or curriculum/catalog assistance ٠

- Delayed transcript, graduation and other evaluations
- Reduced coordination with International Student Program ٠
- Delayed response to Instructional queries
- Reduced ability to respond to Banner bugs and upgrades, testing, etc.
