- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) - \$30
- Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (TdaP) - \$30
- Varicella (Chicken Pox) - \$90/shot (2 required)

#### Other: By Appointment

- Blood Titers (prices vary)
- Birth Control Pills - \$10/pack
- Emergency Contraception ("Morning After Pill") \$20
