DE ANZA COLLEGE HONORS PROGRAM APPLICATION INFORMATION

If you are a **new** student to De Anza, make sure you have submitted an admissions application to the Office of Admissions and Records and make sure that you have taken the English Placement Test. Both new and continuing students must submit the following items:

- 1. Honors Program application
- 2. Typed essay of 500 to 700 words which demonstrates your critical thinking and writing abilities. You may use an essay that was submitted for a college-level class. If you have not yet attended college, you may submit an essay from a junior- or senior-level class.
- 3. Statement of your own reasons for wanting to participate in the Honors Program, its value to you, and what you can contribute to the Program (200 words).
- Recommendation from a teacher who can comment on your critical thinking, writing, or analytical abilities. You should provide the teacher with the attached recommendation form and a stamped envelope.
- 5. A significant portion of the Honors Program is funded by the DASB. All members of the Honors Program are REQUIRED to purchase a DASB card. Please attach to your application a copy of your current DASB card.

<u>If you are a new student</u> and are qualifying based on your high school gpa or based on a gpa earned from a college other than De Anza College.

6. High school and/or college transcripts (other than those from De Anza or Foothill) which record work from the last three years. (The transcript submitted with your Honors application can be a copy of the official transcript but you will need to send an official high school transcript to Admissions and Records when you apply to the college itself.)

If you are a new student and are qualifying based on your SAT or ACT scores. If you are qualifying based on your gpa, you DO NOT need to send copies of test scores.

7. Test score reports from ACT or SAT.

DE ANZA COLLEGE HONORS PROGRAM INFORMATION SHEET

The De Anza College Honors Program is an interdisciplinary learning community for students who enjoy pursuing advanced study, participating in small classes, making connections between disciplines, and collaborating closely with faculty and other students. We seek students who are eager to explore ideas and to take risks.

Honors General Education courses which meet IGETC transfer requirements are offered each quarter and are, in many cases, linked in interdisciplinary clusters. The Honors Program is most appropriate for students who need a minimum of six General Education courses.

PROGRAM GOALS:

- 1. To challenge students to achieve their intellectual potential.
- 2. To improve students' critical thinking, writing, and discussion skills.
- 3. To help students understand the connections between disciplines.
- 4. To encourage closer interaction between the students and the instructor.
- 5. To support timely and appropriate student transfer objectives.

STUDENT BENEFITS:

- 1. Honors sections of General Education courses that parallel university freshman and sophomore classes.
- 2. Small classes which elicit thought-provoking discussions or cohorts of Honors students (within larger classes) who work closely with the professor.
- 3. Linked interdisciplinary classes that reflect the collaboration of faculty in different disciplines who are committed to high standards of teaching and learning.
- 4. Priority registration to ensure enrollment in desired classes.
- 5. Honors recognition on transcripts to indicate achievement to transfer universities.
- 6. Academic and career counseling opportunities available only to Honors students.
- 7. Participation in special events and discussions for the Honors community.
- 8. Completion of 6 Honors courses will earn an "Honors Scholar" Designation on the student's transcript. Students who complete fewer than 6 Honors courses will not receive an Honors designation on the entire transcript, but any courses taken as Honors will receive an Honors designation. Students are still encouraged to apply even if they cannot fulfill all 6 courses before graduation from De Anza College.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Abide by academic integrity and honesty.
- 2. Understand how to write a college-level research paper.
- 3. Enroll in at least one Honors class each guarter.
- 4. Maintain a 3.3 grade point average.
- 5. Meet with the Honors Counselor at least once each year.
- 6. Comply with deadlines for registration, applications to universities, Transfer Admission Agreements (TAAs), etc.
- 7. Notify Honors Program of any change of name, address, phone number, or email address.
- 8. Attend Honors special events (when scheduled).
