



Already Applied? What Happens Next

You will receive an email stating that your international (F-1) application for admission has been received by the International Student Programs Office at De Anza College.

The email will contain the following message:

Your application will now go through a review process.

Students applying from overseas:

- If your application is **COMPLETE**, please allow 2-3 weeks before receiving an email to let you know your admission has been processed and we will send you the admission packet according to your instructions on the application.
- If your application is **INCOMPLETE**, you will receive a “Missing Document” email letting you know what is still missing. Once we receive all of your documents, we will proceed with your admission.

Students transferring from a US school:

- If your application is **COMPLETE**, we will issue you an acceptance letter and send it to you via email with next step instructions to have your SEVIS record transferred.
- If your application is **INCOMPLETE**, you will receive a “Missing Document” email letting you know what is still missing. Once we receive all of your documents, we will issue you an acceptance letter and send it to you via email with next step instructions to have your SEVIS record transferred.

ALERT: DE ANZA CAN ONLY ISSUE AN I-20 AFTER THE SEVIS RECORD from your current US school IS TRANSFERRED. Please allow for 1 to 2 weeks after the SEVIS record is transferred for De Anza to issue you an I-20.

NOTE: The International Student Programs Office @ De Anza College receives a high number of applications. Wait a minimum of 2 weeks from the time you receive this email notification before inquiring about your status if you don't receive any information from our office.
