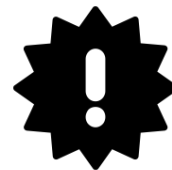

F-1 Students Required Documents

It is **your responsibility** to submit the following documents to the International Student Programs office by the 4th week of your first quarter to avoid a hold on your record:

- Copy of De Anza I-20 *WITH YOUR SIGNATURE!*
 - Copy of previous school's I-20 (*only for students transferring from another U.S. school*)
 - Copy of VISA page (*from passport*)
 - Copy of Port of Entry stamp (*from passport*)
 - Copy of I-94 (*you can access & print from <https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/I94>*)
 - Emergency Form
 - Student Contract Form
 - Proof of Tuberculosis (TB) skin test results (*if the test is positive, you must provide proof of chest X-ray results*)**
 - Proof of Immunizations: Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)**
