SUBJECT: FHDA CCD FRESHMAN FALL ENROLLMENT FROM FEEDER HIGH SCHOOLS
DATE: 4/27/2010

Please find attached to this document enrollment figures for freshmen (i.e., first-time student) at Foothill College and De Anza College for the last five fall terms (2005 to 2009) from feeder high schools in Santa Clara and San Mateo counties. Figures also include the number and percentage of freshmen in fall 2009 placed in college level English courses and the transfer rates for freshmen in the academic years of 2000-01 to 2006-07 at FHDA from feeder high schools by gender and ethnicity.

Following is a brief description of the tables with these figures and related key findings.

- Table 1 shows enrollment figures for freshmen at FHDA from fall 2005 to fall 2009 by feeder high school. As shown by total figures, freshmen fall enrollment at FHDA has increased by about 27% in the last five years, with fall 2008 showing peak figures. This increase in enrollment is significant, especially when taking into account that 12th-grade enrollment for public schools in Santa Clara County¹ in the 2008-09 year only increased by 16%, when compared to related enrollment figures in 2004-05.² Among schools with at least 100 freshmen enrolled in fall 2009 at FHDA, feeder schools in the East Side Union High district showed the largest percentage increase, when compared to their respective figures for fall 2005.³ In Table 1, high schools are sorted in descending order based on their fall 2009 freshman enrollment count at the District, with Fremont High at the top of the list.
- Table 2 shows enrollment figures for freshmen at FHDA from fall 2005 to fall 2009 by high school district. Within Santa Clara County, the East Side Union High district shows the largest number of freshmen at FHDA and the highest percentage increase between fall 2005 and fall 2009. On the other hand, figures show a decline in the number of freshmen at the District from San Mateo County feeder schools between fall 2005 and fall 2009, despite an increase of about 9% in the number of students enrolled in 12th-grade between the academic years of 2004-05 and 2008-09 in this county.
- In Table 3 enrollment figures are segregated by high school district, fall term, and gender. Figures in this table show that male freshmen from feeder high schools in Santa Clara County still outnumber female freshmen by about 23% in fall 2009. However, the number of female freshmen has increased 72% from fall 2005 to fall 2009. For the same time period,

the number of male freshmen from feeder high schools has increased about 22%, a difference of about 50 percentage points between gender groups.

- In Table 4 enrollment figures are segregated by high school district, fall term, and race or ethnicity. For school districts with larger numbers of freshmen in 2009 at FHDA (i.e., East Side Union High, Fremont Union High, Campbell Union High, and San Jose Unified), the number and percentage of Hispanics freshmen coming to FHDA has increased since fall 2005, with East Side Union High showing the highest percentage increase, 31%. The number of Asian freshmen at FHDA from feeder high schools has also increased since fall 2005, with San Jose Unified showing the largest percentage increase, 35%.
- Table 5 shows placement rates on English level courses for freshmen who took at least one English placement test on either Foothill College or De Anza College.⁴ Figures show that for East Side Union High, the high school district with the largest number of freshmen on fall 2009 at FHDA and the highest percentage increase in freshman enrollment between fall 2005 and fall 2009, freshman placement rate in college level English at FHDA is about 10%.
- Table 6 shows figures for transfer rate to a four-year college by gender and race across districts (i.e., county level) for freshmen enrolled at FHDA from 2000-01 to 2006-07 from feeder high schools. Transfer data was obtained from the MIS referential files provided by the CCC Chancellor's Office. In sum, Asian female freshmen from feeder high schools show the highest transfer rate, 45%, and male Latino freshmen show the lowest transfer rate, 11%.
- Table 7 shows transfer rate figures by feeder high school and gender. For schools with higher numbers of freshmen at FHDA in fall 2009 (Fremont High, Independence High, Homestead High, and Oak Grove High), the difference in transfer rates between females and males ranges from nine to seven percentage points, with females showing a higher transfer rates than males across these schools.
- Table 8 shows transfer figures by feeder high school and race or ethnicity. For high schools with higher numbers of freshmen in fall 2009 at FHDA (Fremont High, Independence High, Homestead High, and Oak Grove High), the major gaps in transfer rates among race or ethnic groups are shown between the Hispanic and Asian groups. On average, transfer rates for Asian freshmen at FHDA in these four schools is about 39%, while for Hispanic freshmen is about 17%, a gap of about 22 percentage points. This gap in transfer rates correlates with race or ethnic group API⁵ scores in these schools. API scores for Asian students in these four schools are on average 31 percentage points higher than the API scores for the Hispanic students.

⁴ These figures do not include students who placed into college level English using a different criterion, such as advanced placement, previous enrollment in English courses, or SAT scores.

⁵ API or Academic Performance Index (calculated by California Department of Education, Academic Accountability and Award Division) scores range from 200 to 1000, with 800 as the target for all groups. Mean scores in these four schools for Hispanics was 650, and for Asians was 850.
