
## Instruction - Developmental Students



• 65% of respondents identified as developmental worked with other students on projects <u>during</u> class often or very often (58% non developmental) while 35% (29% non developmental) worked with classmates <u>outside</u> of class often or very often.

• 64% of respondents identified as developmental spend 1-10 hours preparing for class per week, compared to 63% of non developmental respondents.
