Resident and Non-Resident Enrollment

- Total resident and non-resident WSCH is down 2% at 275,780.
- Total resident and non-resident unduplicated headcount is down 3% at 23,599.
- Resident WSCH is down 2% at 241,644.
- Non-resident WSCH is up 4% at 34,136.

International Students

- International students with F1 or FZ visa status increased 6% from fall 2011 to fall 2012 (1,646 to 1,741).
- Females comprise 45% of the international students with F1 or FZ visa status.
- Top countries of origin for F1 or FZ international students includes: China, South Korea and Indonesia.

Online Education

- Total online education estimated WSCH is down 5% at 21,717.
- Online education headcount is down 2% from 3,687 to 3,605.
- Online education course enrollment is down 9% from 5,534 to 5,042.
