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Subject: Student Email Interest Survey

De Anza and Foothill College students were asked to respond to a survey to gather feedback on their interest in being assigned an .edu email address from their respective college. Students were surveyed at the end of the fall 2013 quarter.

At De Anza, the survey was randomly sent to 10,119 students, 1,108 students responded for a response rate of 11%.

At Foothill the survey was sent to 6,728 randomly selected students, 588 students responded for a response rate of 9%, for a combined total of 1,696 respondents at both colleges.

- Out of 1,694 valid responses, 76% (1,294) of respondents states they are interested in an .edu email address
