**Subject:** Follow- up questions to 'Success in BIOL 6A based on pathway into BIOL 6A'

An analysis of BIOL 6A students was performed in August, 2011, based upon this analysis faculty members had additional questions. This document attempts to address those questions.

## 1. Of the students who are enrolled in BIOL 6A, how many repeated the course?

 BIOL 6A students were tracked from 2005-06 to 2010-11 to determine how many students repeat the course. This resulted in 242 (14%) students re-taking the course 2 or more times out of 1,670 students who took the course over the time period. This excludes summer terms.

# 2. What is the success rate of the students who repeated BIOL 6A?

- Students who took the course only once had the highest success rate of 77%.
- None of the students who repeated the course received a successful grade the first time they took the course.
- When including the most recent grade in the course, success rates decreased with each
  additional time the student took the course. For example, students who took the course
  twice had a success rate of 70%. Students who took the course 3 times dropped to 50%
  and students who took the course 4 or more times further dropped to a success rate of 40%.

### 3. How many international students are enrolled in BIOL 6A, and what is their success rate?

- In 2010-11 364 students took BIOL 6A, of those students, 32 (9%) were international students.
- International students had a success rate of 56% while non international students had only a slightly higher success rate of 58%.
