**Subject:** Counseling 100 – Persistence Rates – Summer/Fall 2010 to Fall 2011

First time students are eligible to enroll in COUN100 or 100X in the summer prior to their first term or the fall of their first term. The college enrolled 3,592 first-time students in fall 2010. Of these students, 2,650 enrolled in COUN100 or 100X in the summer and 184 enrolled in the fall. Overall, 79% of first time students in fall 2010 enrolled in COUN100 or 100X in the summer or fall of 2010.

Table 1 presents the persistence rates of students who took COUN100 or 100X in summer 2010. These students were tracked through fall 2010, winter 2011, spring 2011 and fall 2011.
