SUBJECT: Spring 2007 Child Development & Education Department Student Survey

(Latino paper version)

The Spring 2007 Child Development survey was conducted during CD10 and CD54 (17) classes. 54 Latino students responded to the survey.


Important highlights include:

• 92% (84 of 91 responses) of the students indicated that they would attend classes beginning between 4:00pm and 7:00pm (48%) and Saturday classes (44%).

- 91% (49 of 54) of the students indicated that they are taking 6 units or less; 35% are taking 3 or fewer units and 56% are taking 4-6 units.
- 60% (31 of 52) of the students responded that they reside in Mountain View.
- 73% (38 of 53) of the students responded that they are currently employed. The top selected choices were, "Employed, but not in Child Development related work" (25%), and "an aide or assistant teacher" (25%).
- 65% (88 of 135 responses) of the students indicated that they have participated in Community Orientation (21%), Child Development Orientation (26%), and Care Advisor (18%).
- 78% (95 of 121 responses) of the students indicated that Child Development classes in Spanish with English as second language support (32%), study skills class (23%), Child Development/ESL linked classes would help them to be more successful (23%).
- 96% (88 of 92 responses) of the students indicated that their biggest challenges are English is their second language (45%), difficulty with English (27%), and work/family obligations (24%).
- 74% (99 of 136 responses) of the students indicated that multimedia (29%), lecture and discussions (24%), and community service (21%) helped them to be a more effective learner.

12. Which description best suits the classroom/family day care home you currently work in?



13. Which of the following have you participated in while a student in Child Development department?



14. How did you first hear about the Child Development program at De Anza?


