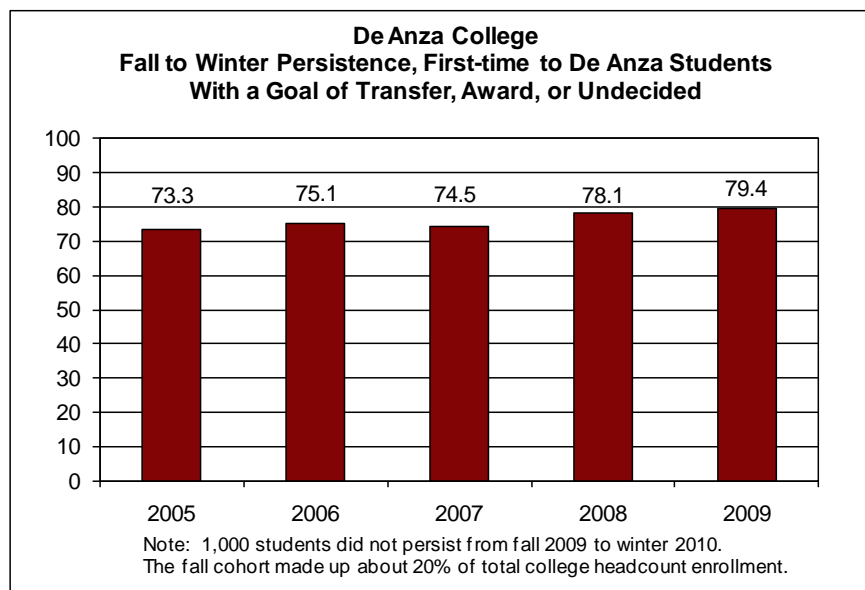

- Total WSCH – Resident and NonResident was up 1% at 272,362
 - Resident WSCH is up 1%
 - Resident Headcount was up 1% at 22,468
 - NonResident WSCH is up about 2%
 - Up 3% for F1 students but down 7% for out of state students
- Distance Learning WSCH is down about 3% winter to winter.
- First time and First time transfer student headcount was down 20% from 1918 to 1527.
- Full time resident student headcount increased 6%.
- Fall to Winter student persistence increased 1 percentage point from 78.1% to 79.4% (see graph below).
