
SUBJECT: Distance Learning Survey, Fall 2007

The Distance Learning Survey was emailed to Distance Learning students on November 16, 2007. The survey was sent to 2,325 students, 255 of which responded (11%). Comparisons of the survey sample to De Anza College demographics as well as survey highlights are included below.

- 72% (183 of 255) of the respondents were female, compared to 61% of distance learning students and 51% of De Anza's total population.
- Full-time students made up 45% (115 of 255) of the respondents; compared to 37% of De Anza's total population.
- 77% (195 of 254) of the respondents indicated that they were only taking one distance learning course.
- 47 % (120 of 255) of the respondents are between the age of 15 and 25; compared to 64.3% of De Anza's total population. 50.5% (139 of 255) of the respondents were over the age of 25; compared to only 36% of De Anza's total population.
- The top educational goal for the of the respondents was to Transfer to a 4-year university with or without obtaining an AA/AS degree (58%, 148 of 255), this compares with 52% for distance learning students and 51% for De Anza's total population.
- 46% (118 of 255) of the respondents live 10-50 miles away from De Anza College.
- 40% (98 of 247) of the respondents would be interested in obtaining their degree fully online. The most popular degrees the surveyed students would seek online are general Business degrees and Business Administration.










12e. Catalyst was easy to navigate (find my way around).



A Performance review for instructors must be included. Instructors must be required to log in at 3-5 separate days to answer all questions or concerns. Once every week is not suitable enough.

A video download option (as opposed to streaming) would be preferable. Also, Real Player is an incredibly invasive program, so I would prefer to be able to use something else.

Ability to speed up video content/pick and select topics that can be listened to rather than thru a 2hr lecture.

An A.A. program that allows all course work to be completed on-line.

As mentioned above, it would be nice if streaming video was available in shorted segments. The lectures could also use editing (there's a lot of dead time).

At Foothill I have taken distance learning classes or classes with an online component - for this class at DeAnza, Catalyst is merely a way to access the video streams, so I don't know much about it. In the case of HTEC 60 at DeAnza, in addition to video streaming for the lecture, it would be nice to be able to submit homework and get grades online, as well as having an online forum within which to communicate with the teacher or other students in the class. 
