**Subject:** Early Registration- Fall 2012

Students with cumulative earned hours between 36 and 90, who declared a major and were enrolled in 12 units or more continuously in fall 2011, winter 2012, and spring 2012 were emailed by Admissions and Records and given an early registration date. The following analysis tracks students who took advantage of the early registration date, the courses they registered for, the courses they were waitlisted for and the demographics of these students.

## Findings include:

- 1,827 students were given an early registration date
- 1,561 (85%) registered for courses in fall 2012
- 257 students were waitlisted for a course

## Demographic Information:

• Of the 1,561 students who registered early, 57% identify as Asian, 14% as Latino or White, and 6% as Filipino.
