Subject: Lead Tracking – Winter 2011 and Spring 2011

Success rates of students enrolled in LEAD courses (EWRT1A, EWRT1B, EWRT002, ICS035, ELIT021, and WMST021, taught by Marc Coronado) were compared to the average success rates of students in all other sections of the same level course in the same quarter. Demographic information for LEAD students in the two quarters was also provided.

Success Rates

Success is defined as A, B, C and P grades, non success is defined as D, F, NP, I and withdraw includes W grades.

- In winter 2011, LEAD students had higher success rates than students in the same level non LEAD course with the exception of ICS035 where LEAD students had lower success rates than students in a non LEAD ICS035 course.
- In spring 2011, LEAD students exhibited higher success rates than students in the same level non LEAD course; this is the case for all LEAD courses offered this quarter.

Demographics

- LEAD students largely identified as Asian (27%-29%) and Latino (21%-24%) followed by Multi-Ethnic (13%-14%) and White (14%) in winter and spring 2011.
- Over 60% of LEAD students were enrolled full-time in both quarters.
- Over 40% of LEAD students had a GPA between 3.1 and 4.0.
- The gender distribution of LEAD students is about equal.
