Subject: MPS Success Rates 2009-10 to 2010-11

Success rates for the Math Performance Success program were calculated for fall 2009, winter 2010, spring 2010, fall 2010, winter 2011 and spring 2011. Non MPS sections of MATH 212, 210, 114 and 10 was also included as a comparator.

From 2009-10 to 2010-11 the following changes were made to the program: 3 additional sections were added in 2010-11: 1 section of MATH 114, 1 section of MATH 210 and 1 section of MATH 10. 88 additional students received a grade in 2010-11 than in 2009-10. Three new instructors were added to the program in 2010-11 that had not taught in the program the year prior. An academic advisor was added to the program in 2010-11.

Findings Include:

- Success rates in MPS courses were 80% in 2009-10 and 76% in 2010-11. Success rates of all non MPS math comparator sections were 56% in 2009-10 and 57% in 2010-11.
- Success rates for MPS MATH 212 decreased from 76% in 2009-10 to 68% in 2010-11. Success rates in non MPS MATH 212 comparator sections were at 54% in 2009-10 and 2010-11.
- Success rates for MPS MATH 210 courses decreased from 78% in 2009-10 to 66% in 2010-11. Success rates in non MPS MATH 210 comparator sections were at 52% in 2009-10 and increased to 57% in 2010-11.
- Success rates for MPS MATH 114 courses increased from 79% in 2009-10 to 82% in 2010-11. Success rates in non MPS MATH 114 comparator sections were at 58% in 2009-10 and 2010-11.
- Success rates for MPS MATH 10 courses decreased from 85% in 2009-10 to 78% in 2010-11. Success rates in non MPS MATH 10 comparator sections were at 57% in 2009-10 and 59% in 2010-11.

Possibilities for Additional Analysis:

- The MPS program may choose to survey their students regarding their perception of the program.
 - $\circ\,$ Whether students feel they are more successful academically because of their enrollment in the MPS program.

- Whether students feel that their interaction with the academic advisor and academic counselor helped them be successful in the program and at De Anza.
- Survey faculty members on their perception of student success in the program, the effectiveness of the academic counselor and the academic advisor.
