

CompTechS - NSF Success Results for Fall 2007

The analysis below includes CompTechS - NSF students enrolled in fall 2007. The 46 students enrolled in 155 courses in fall 2007. 95% of the group had registered for winter 2008 by January 10, 2008. 7 of the 46 or 15% of the group were female. Data includes both Foothill and De Anza course registrations.
