SUBJECT: Nursing Program Theory Survey, Spring 2012

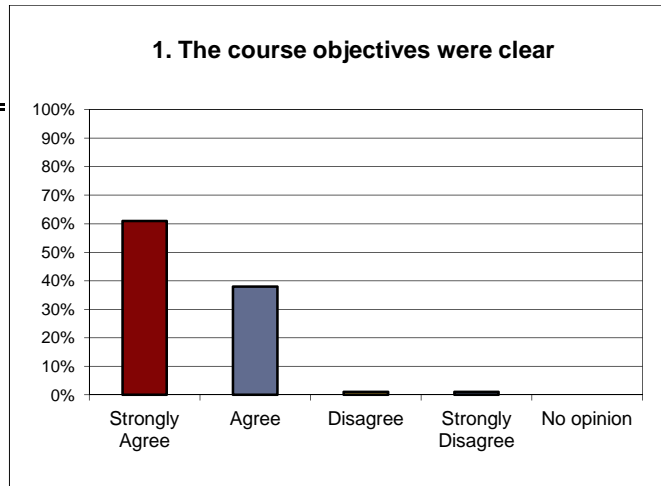
A survey was sent by Nursing Program faculty to students of De Anza College enrolled in the Nursing Program during Spring quarter 2012. A total of 168 students responded to the online survey.

Important highlights include:

- 99% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the course objectives were clear.
- 98% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the objectives of the course were obtainable.
- 96% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the complexity of the course was appropriate for this level; and the tests (quizzes, etc.) in this course related to the course objectives.
- 94% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the topics covered in exams and assignments for this course were consistent with the course objectives; the assigned reading and A.V.s for this course were appropriate; and the out-of-class assignments (eg., A.V., group activities, etc.) were relevant to the course objectives.
- 93% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the out-of-class suggested reading and A.V. assignments were accessible; and the course has helped them to improve in clinical performance.
- 92% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the assigned papers for this course contributed to the achievement of course objectives.
- 90% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that compared to other courses in their major, they would rate this course as effective.
- 89% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the amount of work required for this course was appropriate for the credit received; and the lectures/demonstrations in the course were appropriate.
- 88% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the required textbook for this course was helpful for meeting the objectives; and the class time allowed for discussion and questions was appropriate.
- 85% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the course was well structured (ie., the progression seemed logical).
- 83% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the methods for presenting content were effective.

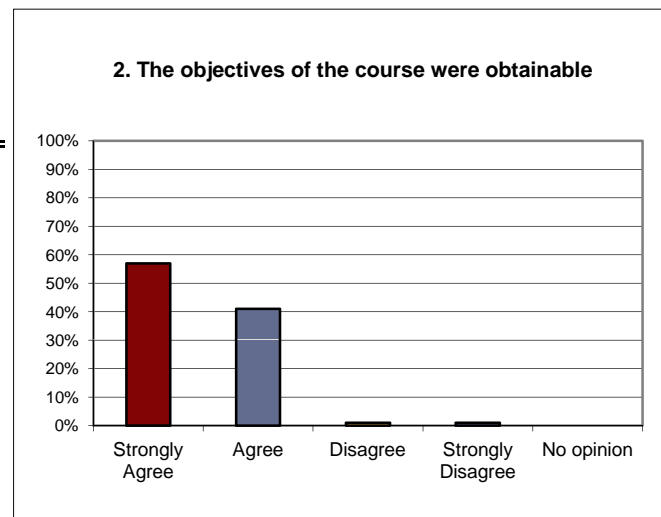

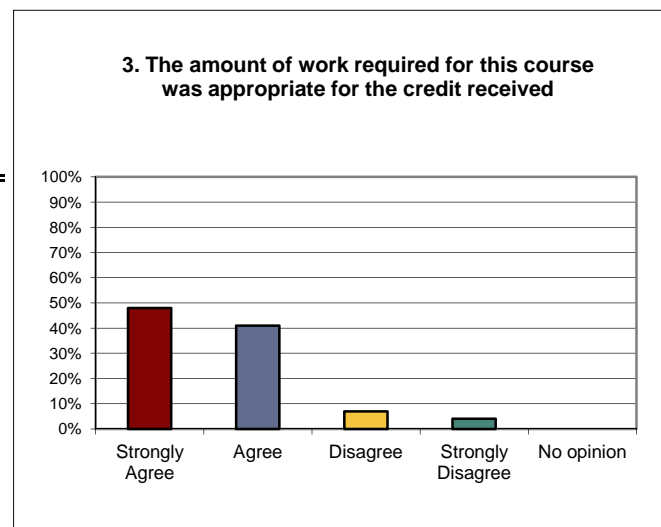

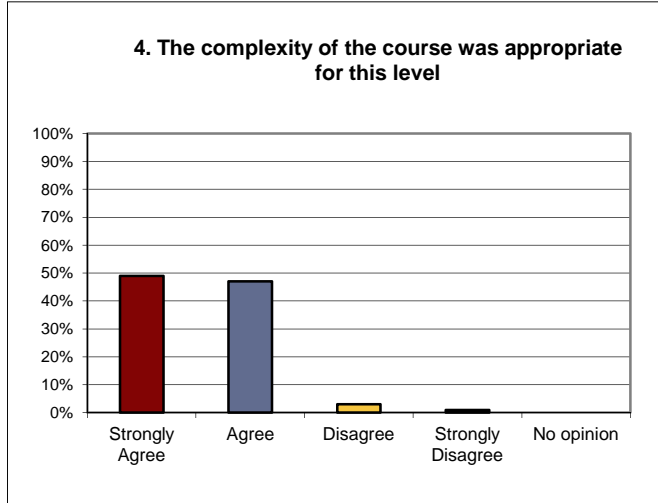

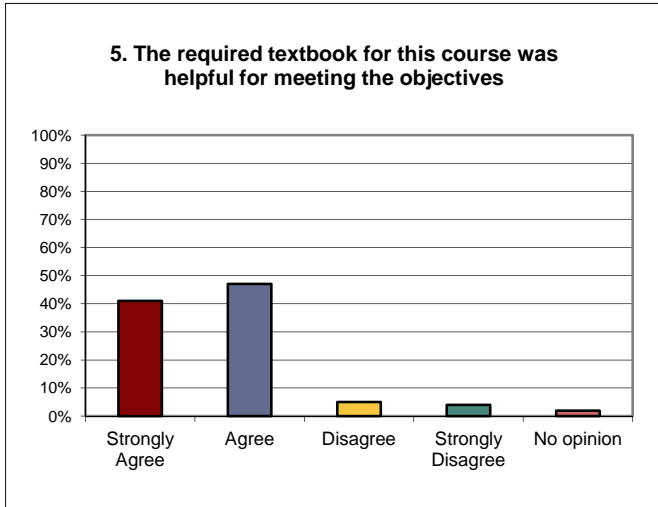
4. The complexity of the course was appropriate for this level

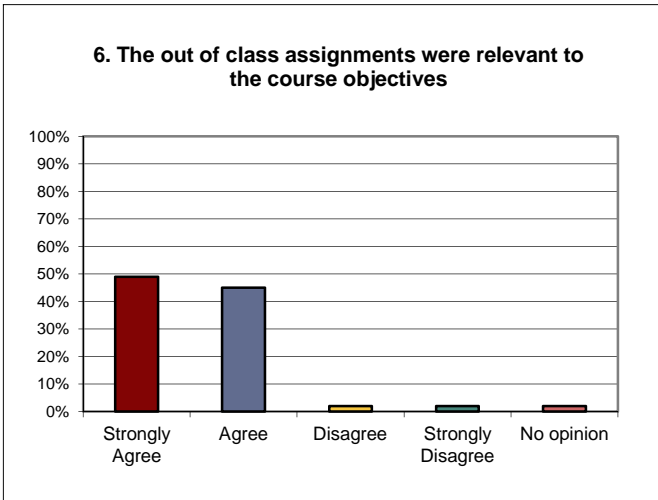

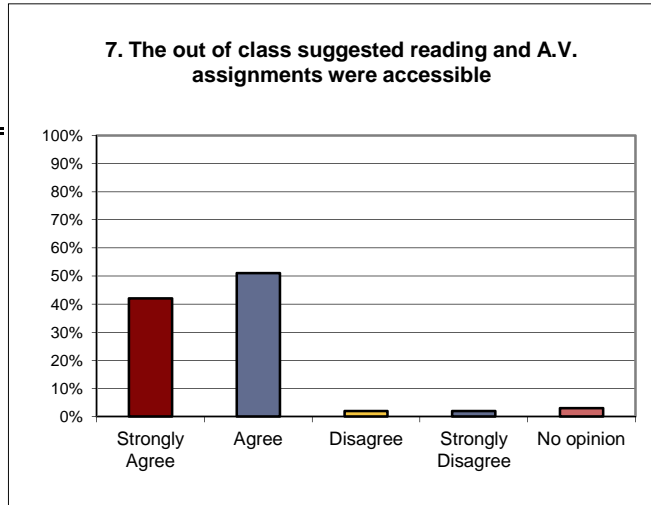

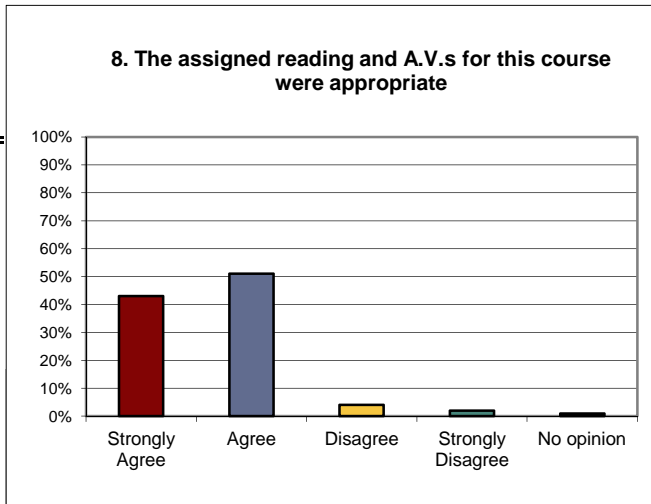

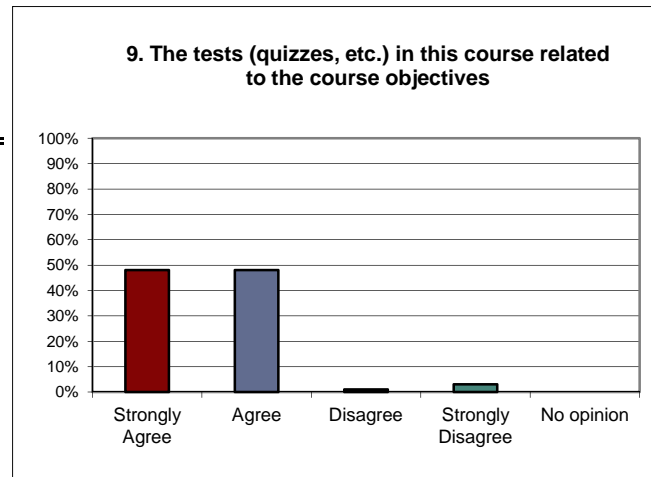

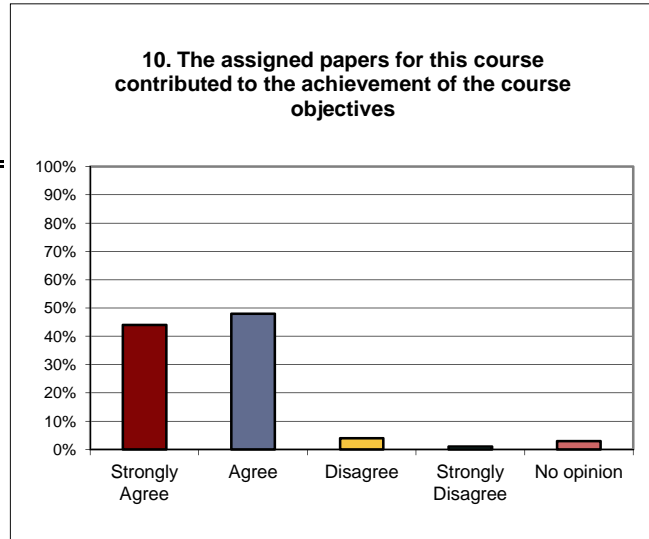

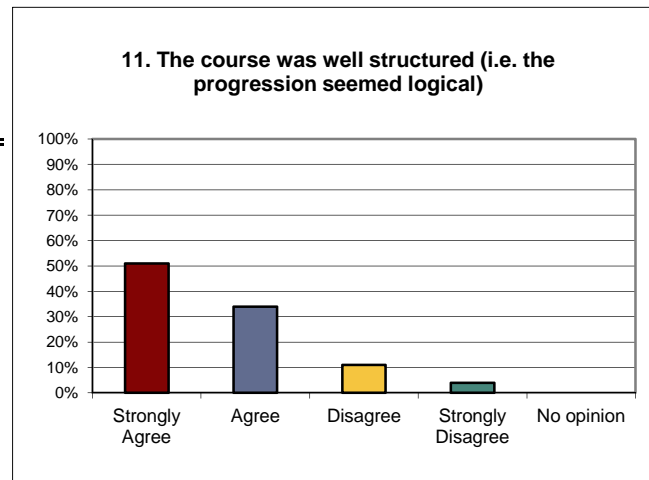

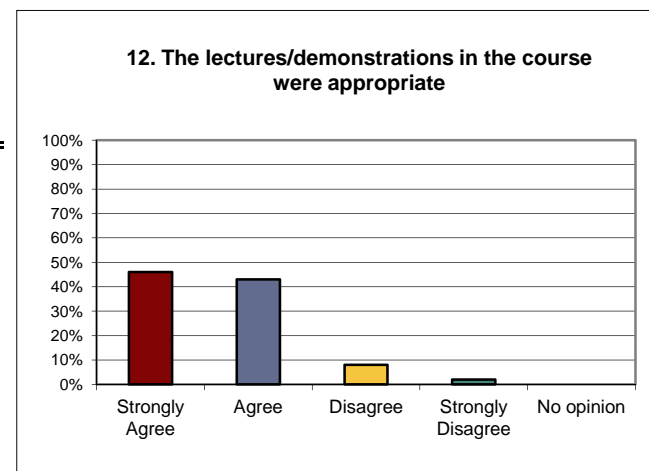

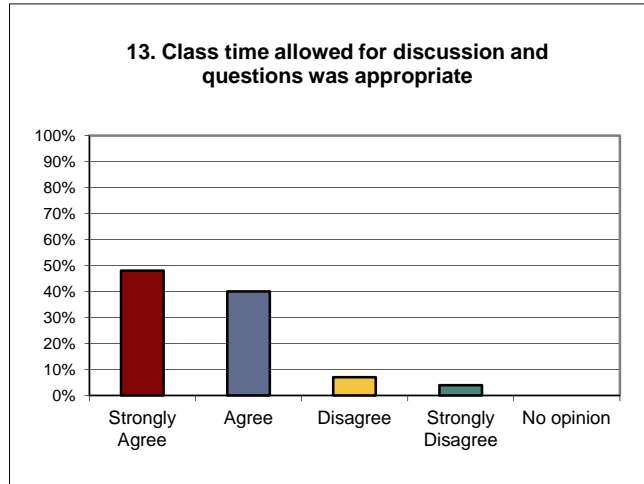

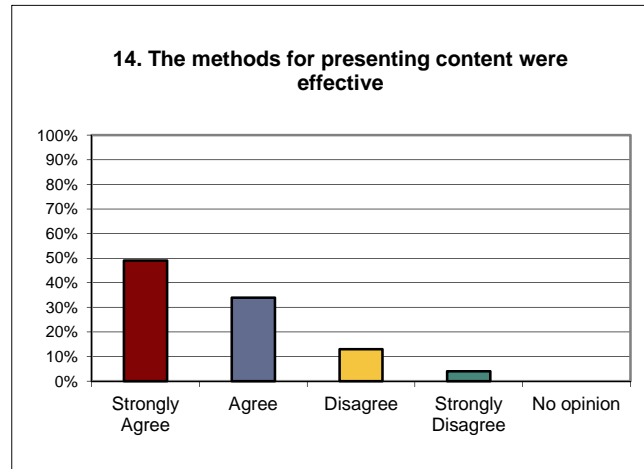

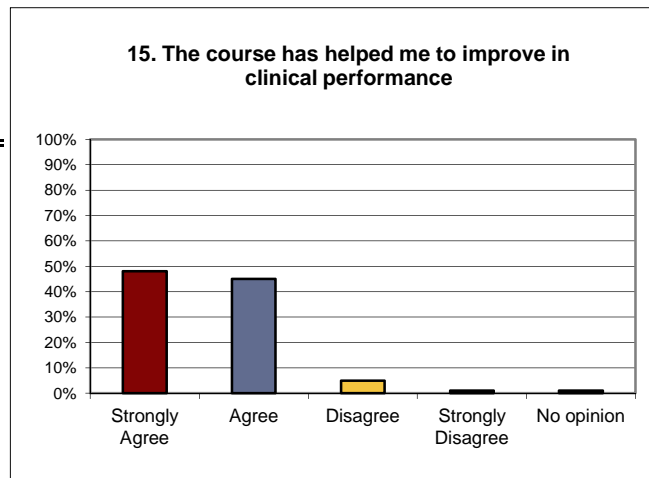

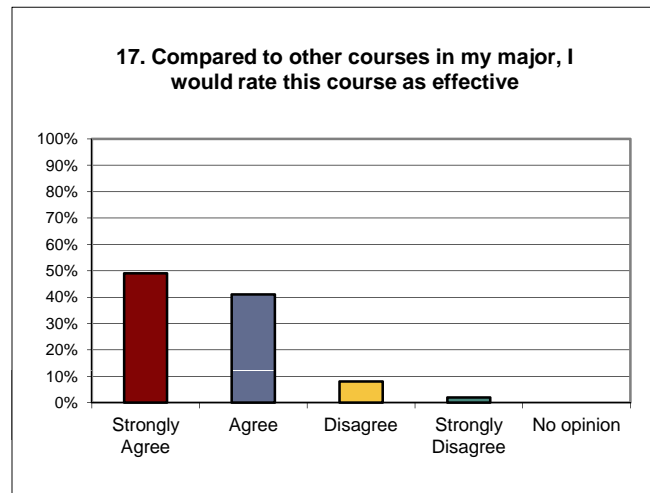
