- 34 class sections participated in the survey with a total of 823 valid survey responses.









How much does this college emphasize each of the following?







How satisfied are you with the academic advising and planning services?









Benchmark Comparison to 2007 CCSSE

- The Student Effort Benchmark has increased by 4.3; the score difference has increased from -3.9 compared to the 2007 CCSSE cohort to +0.4 compared to the 2009 CCSSE cohort
- The Academic Challenge Benchmark has increased by 2.3; the score difference has increased from -0.2 compared to the 2007 CCSSE cohort to +2.1 compared to the 2009 CCSSE cohort.
- The Student Faculty Interaction Benchmark has decreased by 0.5; the score difference has decreased from -3.2 compared to the 2007 CCSSE cohort to -3.7 compared to the 2009 CCSSE cohort.
- In 2007, all benchmark categories except Active and Collaborative Learning were below the 2007 CCSSE cohort. In 2009, all are above except for Student Faculty Interaction and Support for Learners.
