Linda, in 2004F, 2005W, 2005S, 2005M there were 847 Liberal Arts AND University Transfer students at De Anza granted an AA.

Of the 847, 438 (52%) enrolled in a distance learning section (ending in Z) at some point in their academic career at De Anza (going back to 1994). 250 of th 438 took 2 or more distance learning sections.
