Hi all, as we look at the summer enrollment figures, it is important to keep in mind that Job Corps in Summer 2006 accounted for almost 25% of total WSCH (estimated 35,000 out of 130,000). Based on the last couple quarters, it is likely that JC will come in at about 30% below the 2006M level -- about 10,000 WSCH off.

Right now we appear to be about 10,000 WSCH ahead of last year (although 2006M was down on-campus compared to 2005M). At this point, about 35+% of the summer WSCH is yet to be logged (remember, some departments run sections with mid July start dates). Given a strong on-campus enrollment in Spring, we should expect higher on-campus numbers in Summer -- we have already seen a strong international student enrollment in 2007M compared to last year. However, it is unclear where we will land overall.
