

Fall 2007 to Fall 2008 Census Comparisons

Highlights include:

- * Fall 2008 headcount (including Job Corps and NonResidents) was nearly 26,000 or up about 6%. Total WSCH was up about 8%.
- * Resident WSCH is up about 7% fall 2007 to fall 2008.
- * Special Education and Student Services Division course enrollment was down.
- * Distance Learning WSCH is up about 17% fall to fall.
- * Job Corps WSCH is up about 1% fall to fall after a summer increase of about 80%.
- * Latino/a Resident (non Job Corps) headcount increased 369 or about 12% fall to fall. Latino/a Resident students accounted for 14.7% of headcount in fall 2007, and 15.6% in fall 2008.
- * Firsttime to college Latino/a Resident (non Job Corps) headcount increased 46 or about 39% fall to fall.
- * Continuing student Resident (non Job Corps) headcount is up about 4% fall to fall. Firsttime student (Firsttime to college and Firsttime to De Anza) WSCH was up about 15% while headcount was up 664 or about 12%.
- * Day section WSCH was up about 10% while Evening section WSCH was up about 1%.
