Resident and Non-Resident Enrollment Categories

- Within the resident category, total enrollment of AB540 students decreased 16% from 2,297 to 1,931 while FTES decreased 12% from 229 to 202.
- Within the non-resident category, enrollment of students from another country (with or without an educational visa) decreased 4% from 7,479 to 7,150 while FTES decreased 4% from 782 to 751.

International Students

- International students with F1 or FZ visa status headcount is at 1,963.
- Females comprise 47% of the international students with F1 or FZ visa status.
- Top countries of origin for F1 or FZ international students includes: China, Vietnam, South Korea, Japan and Taiwan.

Ethnicity

- Latino/a headcount decreased 1% from 5,255 to 5,212 and FTES decreased 1 from 1,367 to 1,347.
- African American headcount decreased 6% from 830 to 779 and FTES decreased 5% from 218 to 208.
- Filipino headcount decreased 4% from 1,472 to 1,415 while FTES decreased 5% from 406 to 384.

Student Type

- First-time student headcount increased 6% from 410 to 434 and FTES increased 3% from 96 to 99.
- First-time transfer student headcount increased 10% from 1,218 to 1,341 while FTES increased 10% as well from 214 to 236.
- Continuing student headcount decreased 4% from 16,958 to 16,254 and FTES decreased 6% from 5,036 to 4,750. This suggests that students retained from fall to winter decreased this winter compared to last winter.
- Returning student headcount increased 4% from 1,721 to 1,787 and FTES increased 3% from 310 to 320.
- High school student enrollment increased 23% from 233 to 286.

- Headcount from San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward and East Palo Alto also remained constant at 51% of total headcount.
- Headcount from San Jose Other, Santa Clara, Morgan Hill, Gilroy, and Campbell decreased 1 percentage point.
