

Opening Day Enrollment Notes Spring 2007  
 April 10, 2007 compared to April 11, 2006

- At face Spring 2007 opening day enrollment appears to be about even with opening day 2006, however, assuming stable PE enrollment (taking into account the move to Life Long Learning Courses), De Anza College opening day enrollment is up more than 3% in WSCH. (Note: this does not include Job Corps enrollment).
- International (F1) student enrollment is up nearly 20% over the previous quarter.
- Evening section enrollment is off about 2% in headcount.
- English / Writing enrollment is up about 15%
- The weakest sector of enrollment is with **Continuing** students, rather than new and returning students.
- Enrollment this quarter continues with the trend towards a higher percentage of students indicating their initial goal as Transfer or Degree. (see figure below)
