

Winter 2006 to Winter 2007 Census Enrollment Trends

De Anza Research, January 24, 2007

Observations

- 1) De Anza College enrollment appears to be off by about 1%, assuming end-of-term PE enrollment is equal to winter 2006 enrollment.
- 2) Winter 2007 Job Corps enrollment is off by about 1/3 from winter 2006.
- 3) Assuming flat PE enrollment, “on-campus” (not including job corps) enrollment is up more than 2% in headcount and more than 5% in WSCH (almost half of this increase can be attributed to F1 international students).
- 4) Assuming flat PE enrollment, “on-campus” (not including job corps) enrollment in day sections is up 6% in WSCH, while evening section enrollment is up 3%.
- 5) Computer Information Systems course enrollment is up 1% from winter 2006 to winter 2007.
- 6) The number of F1 students (paying full tuition) is up about 200 students or 20% (typically about 90% of these students will be full time).
- 7) Enrollment of individuals indicating that they are immigrants with permanent resident status is off by about 1/3 or about 350 students.
- 8) 307 students were dropped for non-payment and did not re-enroll.

Caveats

- Beginning Fall 2006, P E has moved from “500” credit to noncredit Life Long Learning courses (LLPE). LLPE WSCH (with 75% apportionment) will not be known until the end of the term.
- The WSCH variable is an estimate which includes the maximum hours for positive attendance courses and thus likely represents a slight overestimate.
- The FTES variable represents actual hours to date and does not include positive attendance hours and thus is likely an underestimate.
