I looked at Fall 2006 enrollments in hour blocks starting at 4pm (all classes starting at 8pm or later were grouped together).

* It is roughly 50/50 female to male in the evening, except for the 5-5:59pm start time period, where it is 60% female.

* The most popular time slot for high school students was 6-6:59 pm, with almost 60% of the roughly 400 evening high school students taking a class that started between 6 and 6:59pm.

* 65% of 4-4:59 time slot students are 21 and older. It is 80% 21 and older for all the other evening time slots.

* 60% of the evening enrollments are in classes starting between 6 and 6:59pm.
