Methodology: Visa status group derived from RDB Census Student Extract by Term. Students with a F1 and FZ Visa Code are included. Note, it is possible for students to have more than one visa code over the four quarters. The resulting file is merged with the student billing file for the subcode 13001 - NonResident Tuition. Charges are summed over the four quarters for the one subcode. In this analysis, out of state nonresidents are students with no visa code but with a billing subcode of 13001.
