SUBJECT: Nursing Program Clinical Survey, Winter 2009

A survey was sent to students of De Anza College Nursing Program during Winter quarter 2009. A sample of 244 students responded to the survey.

### Important highlights include:

- 97% of students "agreed" or "strongly agreed" that student's clinical objectives and responsibilities were stated in a clear and understandable manner.
- 92% of students "agreed" or "strongly agreed" that learning experiences were selected based on individual student needs.
- 98% of students "agreed" or "strongly agreed" that clinical assignments related theory to implementation.
- 88% of students "agreed" or "strongly agreed" that the course demonstrated understanding and sensitivity to student needs.
- 92% of students "agreed" or "strongly agreed" that the course provided supportive feedback for students, offering suggestions for self improvement when necessary.
- 94% of students "agreed" or "strongly agreed" that the course encouraged realistic goals for student performance.

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










