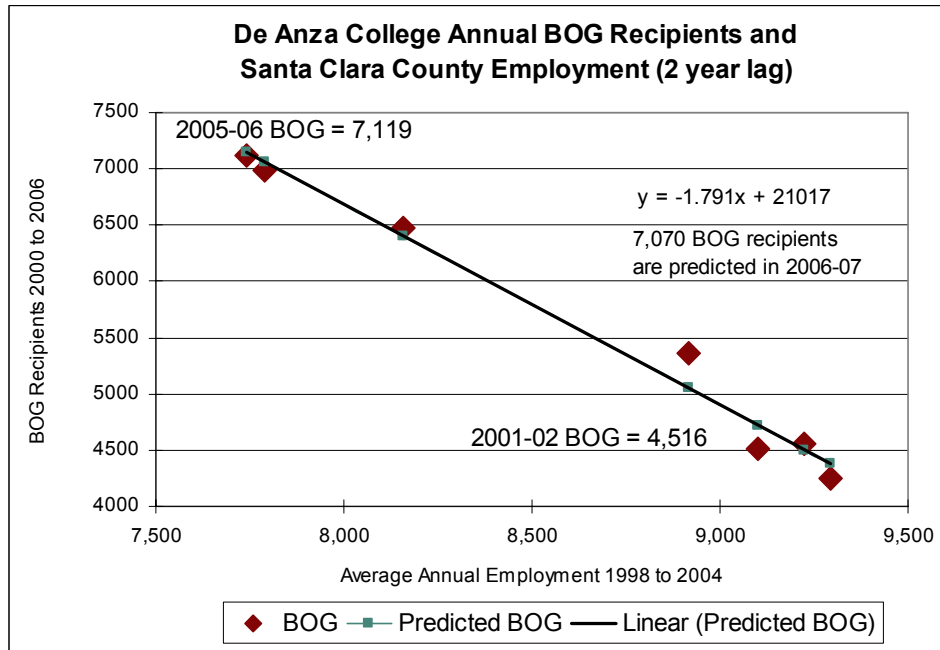


De Anza College Student Financial Aid Trends, Year End 2005 and 2006
 October 31, 2006, Andrew LaManque, De Anza Research
 (Please see the attached information on students receiving financial aid.)

- The unduplicated number of students receiving aid is up 141 students or 2% from 7,283 in 2005 to 7,424 in 2006.
- Pell Grant recipients are down 2% from 2005 to 2006.
- BOG recipients are up 2% from 2005 to 2006. 96% of financial aid recipients received a BOG award.
- 54% of Vietnamese students received some type of aid, compared with 16% for White, 26% for Mexican American, and 33% for African American students.
- The percentage of financial aid students indicating degree or transfer as their initial goal has increased from 59% to 63% from 2005 to 2006.
- Based on employment figures in 2004-05, it is predicted that the number of BOG recipients in 2006-07 will decline to 7,070 (from 7,119). The tuition drop in spring 2007 and outreach efforts should act to mitigate this drop.



- Based on National Student Clearinghouse records, 5.5% (405 out of 7,422) financial aid and 5.1% (1,405 out of 27,391) non-financial aid students had enrollment at a 4 year institution in fall 2006. (Note: all students – including students starting in 2005-06 -- were included in the analysis).

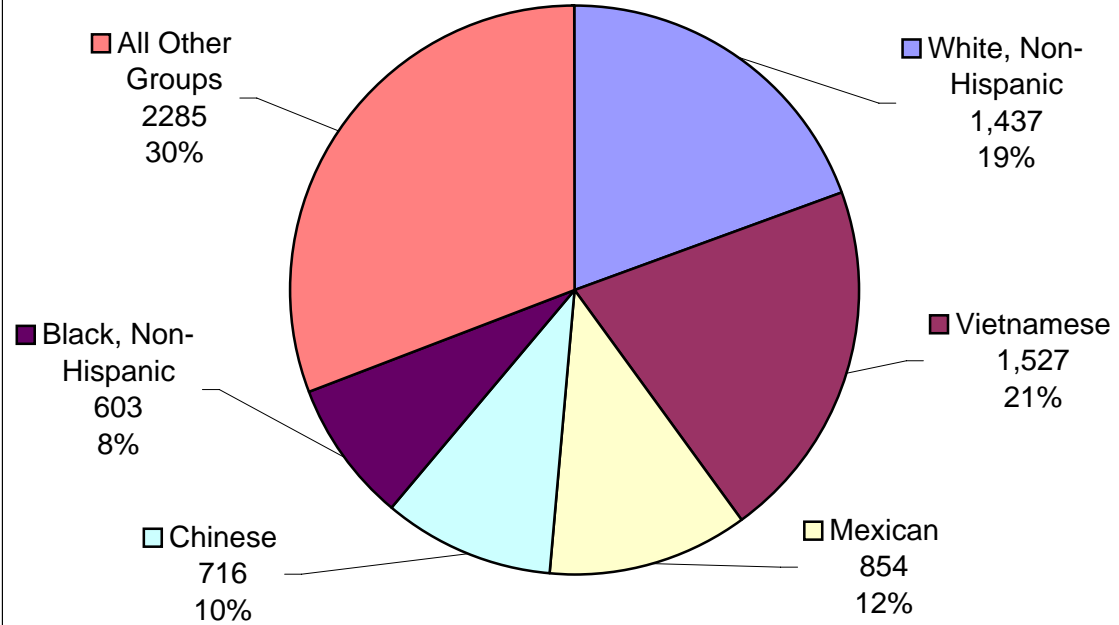
