SUBJECT: De Anza Transfer Students Enrolled at San Jose State University (SJSU)

The tables below outline enrollment of De Anza College students at SJSU, comparing 2003-04 with 2004-05. Except where noted, most charts show data for all students enrolled at SJSU, including both new transfers and continuing students.

### Observations

- Spring 2005 enrollment of new transfers of 379 is down 16% from 452 in Spring 2004.
- Duplicated fall and spring enrollment in computer related majors (Computer Science, MIS, Acct Info Systems) is off 16% in 2004-05 compared with 2003-04 (635 to 534).
- About 55% of De Anza transfer students at SJSU in 2004-05 were female, which is slightly higher than their representation in the overall campus population.
- About 2/3 of De Anza transfer students at SJSU in 2004-05 were attending full time, which is about twice the rate of all students enrolled at De Anza.
- In 2004-05 the ethnicity of De Anza students enrolled at SJSU included a slightly higher percentage of Asian and less African American and Hispanic students than were found in the Fall 2004 De Anza population.

Our agreement with SJSU includes access to individual record detail for the purpose of improving educational practice. If interested, the variables included in this analysis can be compared to student information from the De Anza student information system.
