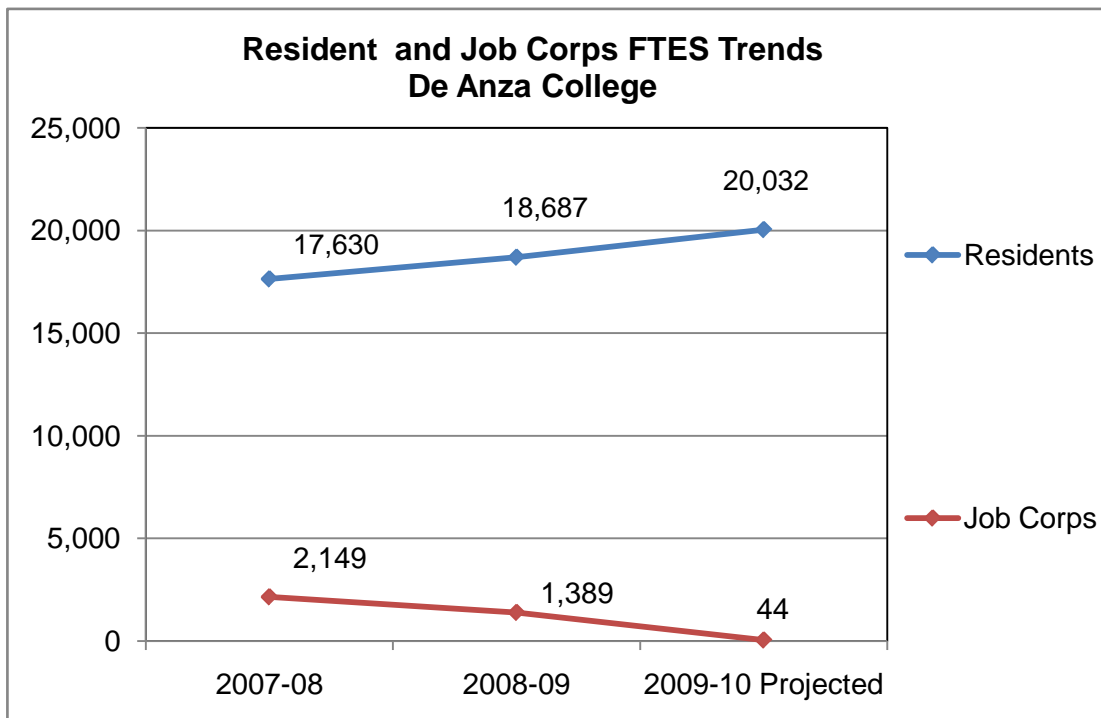
- Total WSCH – Resident and NonResident was down 4% at 267,189
 - Resident WSCH is down 5%
 - Resident Headcount was up 2% at 20,347
 - NonResident WSCH is up about 3%
 - Up 6% for F1 students but down 15% for out of state students

- Local Resident WSCH (not including Job Corps) is up about 5% and headcount is up about 9%, spring 2008 to spring 2009.

- Job Corps reductions amounted to over 22,000 WSCH (about 8% of total WSCH) and 1,200 students.

- Distance Learning WSCH is up about 1% spring to spring.

- Fulltime student (Resident, not including Job Corps) headcount increased 918 students or 14% from 6,753 in spring 2008 to 7,671 in spring 2009.

The following six tables display the Start of Third Week Enrollment Indicators Report for Spring 2009 (i.e., at the end of Monday or Census Day)*.

Highlights from the tables of findings:

- De Anza's overall estimated WSCH is down 4.4% compared to the corresponding point last year **. Foothill's is up 5.2%. The District is down 0.9%.
- Headcount is up more than WSCH at both colleges, for a 3.6% headcount increase for the district compared a 0.9% WSCH decrease.
- Weekly Census class WSCH is up by 5.0% at De Anza and 8.6% at Foothill.
- Non-resident WSCH is up compared to last year by 3.0% at De Anza but is down 5.8% at Foothill ***.
- Total district Credit WSCH is down 0.3% while total district Noncredit WSCH is down 33.6% reflecting planned reductions by Foothill in Adaptive Learning.
- Resident only Credit Weekly Census class WSCH is up 5.1% at De Anza and 10.7% at Foothill.

* Job Corps registrations have been posted for this year as well as last. Only some of the Performance Alliance registrations have been posted at the point for last year (54 FTES) but virtually none for this year. End-of-Term Performance Alliance FTES is usually about 450.

** Note, if we exclude Job Corps [this year and last year] then De Anza's headcount would be up 9% and WSCH about 5%.

*** Foothill F1/FZ Visa Holder headcount enrollment is flat while WSCH is down about 3%. De Anza F1/FZ Visa Holder headcount enrollment is up 8% while WSCH is up about 3%.
