- International students with F1 or FZ visa status increased 7% from 1,741 to 1,863.
- Females comprise 44% of the international students with F1 or FZ visa status.

- Total online education estimated WSCH is down 1% at 21,405.
- Online education headcount is up 3% from 3,605 to 3,730.
