

## De Anza College Summer 2011 and 2012 Census Enrollment Comparisons Report

### From summer 2011 to summer 2012:

#### Resident and Non-Resident Enrollment

- Total resident and non-resident WSCH is down 7% at 95,297.
- Total resident and non-resident unduplicated headcount is down 6% at 14,255.
- Resident WSCH is down 7% at 85,835.
- Non-resident WSCH is up 3% at 9,462.

- Latino/a student enrollment increased 1 percentage point from 2,424 to 2,498.
- White student enrollment decreased 1 percentage point from 3,140 to 2,824.
- Unrecorded decreased 2 percentage points from 1,029 to 718.

### International Students

- The headcount of F-1 students is up from 810 to 840.

### One Course Takers

- Students enrolling in only one course decrease 6% from summer 2011 to summer 2012 from 8,923 to 8,411.
- Students taking 3 courses decreased at the lowest rate at 4%, from 1,522 to 1,456.
