**Subject:** Veterans Identified from the CCCApply Application – 2013-14 to 2014-15

The Veterans Office requested a count of students who identified as one of the 5 veteran categories on the CCCApply application, who were enrolled at De Anza between summer 2013 and spring 2015. This count will not include students who were identified as receiving services at the Veterans Office or identified in banner as a Veteran Cohort. This report only identifies students who self-identified as a veteran category on their admission application. The analysis includes the average cumulative units earned per group at De Anza up to the term displayed.
