SKILLS TESTING GUIDELINES

- 1, All students are skills tested in the Skills lab each quarter on two skills, one current quarter skills and one from 1 of the previous quarters.
- 2. If the student fails a skill twice, slhe will receive a Plan for Clinical Improvement (PCI) which may extent to next quarter.
- 3. All students are strongly encouraged to enroll in Nursing 150 in order to practice all learned skills.
- 4. Early skills testing will be offered for those students enrolled *in* Nursing 150, and who have completed at least haft of their unit hrs.
- 5. Criteria sheets identify only the <u>critical elements</u> for each skill. They are not step-by-step description on how to perform the skill.
- 6. In order to pass the skill successfully the student must perform every identified critical element. Both evaluators must agree you failed.
- 7. Remember that the key to success in skills testing is <u>Practice Practice and more Practice</u>. The more you practice the more likely you are to succeed.
- 8. In case of a failure, you will be told which critical element(s) you failed and you will be required to do a Retake of that specific skill.
- 9. If you fail the skill during the retake, you will be shown the critical element(s) you failed and you will be given a PC) on that skill(s).
- 10. PCI Skill(s) Retake must be completed during the first 3 weeks in the next quarter. You will not be allowed to perform the pending skill(s) in the clinical setting, until you have demonstrated that skill correctly in the lab.
- 11. The PCI will include mandatory enrollment in Nursing 150 and mandatory Early Skills Testing next quarter on any ~ previous skills. The student will then be required to attend Regular Skills testing and be tested on a current quarter's skill and any skill from previous quarters during Final Week with all other students.
