Course Conclusion

- Faculty request a course shell for all new courses.
- Course shell is created by Online Ed
- Faculty can create content from scratch or migrate course material into Canvas (from Catalyst or other Canvas Instances).
- These shells will become the "Master Shells" for their courses.
- Four weeks
 before the term
 starts, Faculty
 can request
 activation of
 their course via
 MyPortal.
- Activation will create an empty, unpublished shell.
- Students will be added real-time but can't see the course until the term start date (determined by Online Ed) AND when the teacher publishes the course.

- Faculty will load the content from their Master Shell into their activated course(s).
- Course import happens in the "Settings" area of your activated course.
- Use the "Import Content" option.

- Faculty publish their course when it is ready, by the first day of the quarter.
- Students will not be able to access it until the term start date that is set by Online Ed.
- Once the term has concluded, faculty will no longer be able to access the course.
- Faculty should plan to copy their course before conclusion if they want that content for future quarters.
- No student data will be saved on the copied version of the course.
