The CalSUCCESS Mission

Our mission is to provide students receiving federal FOOD STAMPS* with an affordable college education that will lead to financial stability and lifelong learning.

CalSUCCESS is one of the programs offered by the Occupational Training Institute (OTI). OTI is a workforce department of the Foothill-De Anza Community College District serving students in economic transition.

*Note: Students receiving cash-benefits are not eligible for CalSUCCESS and should contact OTI for information about the CalWORKs program.

Eligibility

Eligibility for FOOD STAMPS is determined by the Social Services agency in your county of residence. Prospective low-income students need to call their nearest Social Services department for FOOD STAMP eligibility.
